THAT'S WHAT MY PREACHER PREACHES—IT MUST BE SO

Have you ever had a religious discussion with someone and they tried to prove their point by saying, "that's what my preacher preaches and it must be so." Some people will use their preacher as the final authority in religious matters.

It is believed by some that if the preacher states it, it has to be right and cannot be wrong. Some think that their preacher or any other preacher would never lie nor deceive them. So, they go through life blindly accepting and doing whatever the preacher says.

Does not the Bible teach that we are to put to the test those who teach (1 John 4:1)? Let us be like the Bereans who "searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so" (Acts 17:11).

Some believe it is wrong to question the teachings of any preacher. In fact, I have encountered some preachers who thought they were "above being questioned" about their belief, teaching and practice. But, we must examine what is being taught no matter who the proclaimer may be. It doesn't matter the popularity, prestige, power or personality of the preacher, put him to the test. Examine what he proclaims & practices in light of what is taught in the Bible. This examination must be done because (1) God commands it (1 John 4:1); (2) Hearers can be led astray (2 Peter 2:1-3) and (3) the preacher must "Preach the word" (2 Tim. 4:2) to please God.

It is certainly possible for a preacher to teach false doctrine (Matthew 7:15). If he does, then out of love, he must be corrected. Apollos, a preacher, had to be corrected for some of the things he was teaching (Acts 18:26). The belief by some that the preacher is "hands-off" concerning his belief, teaching and practice is not in the Bible. What does your preacher preaches?

Does your preacher preach a "**corrupt**" message? When one teaches a "corrupt" doctrine is he speaking the "Truth"? Not according to God's Word. God's Word is truth (John 17:17). It is possible to teach a corrupt or perverted message (Galatians 1:6-9).

Does your preacher fail to teach the "**complete**" Truth? When a person will not declare the "whole" truth, is he speaking that which is "Truth"? Declaring a "partial" message is not pleasing to God. Paul kept back nothing that was profitable (Acts 20:20) nor had he shunned to declare all the counsel of God (Acts 20:27).

Does your preacher preach a "**compromising**" message? A person who proclaims a "compromising" gospel is not teaching that which is "true". God doesn't want something watered down, diluted message, but the Truth (2 Timothy 4:2; Gal. 1:6-9).

Is your preacher more concerned about speaking a "**comforting**" message than a message that is needed? When one is more concerned about speaking "smooth things" than "right things", he is not speaking the "Truth" (Isa. 30:10). Paul in 2 Timothy 4:2-4 makes it very clear that the message to be proclaimed is "the Word" and it must be preached "in season and out of season". Let us realize it is God's Word (John 12:48) that is our standard of authority and not the "words of man". Don't trust your eternal destiny upon man's word but upon God and His Word (Proverbs 3:5-6).


