DO YOU LOVE GOD'S LAW?

The Psalmist expressed this inspired sentiment regarding the Word of God— *“Oh, how love I Your law! It is my meditation all the day”* (Psa. 19:97). Wesley Simons recently wrote an article in the publication *The More Sure Word* in which he told the story of Gus Nichols, who, on one occasion when he had finished preaching, was shaking hands with those who were exiting the building. One lady said to him, “I would give the world to know the Bible the way you do.” Brother Nichols replied, “Dear, that is what it cost me.” Brother Nichols was a diligent student of scripture who spent many hours in the study of God’s Word so that he could impart it’s saving message to others. Like the Psalmist, brother Nichols loved God’s law.

How many hours a week do you spend in the study of the Bible, dear reader? Do you love God’s Law? Do you meditate upon it throughout your day? Sadly, there are far too many who only open their Bible during Bible class or worship, but hardly ever at home. Is that sufficient? Does that express a genuine love for God’s Law?

No one can love God’s law while ignorant of it. The New Testament is God’s spiritual law to which every accountable person who is living today is subject. It is that which will judge us in the last day (John 12:48). Yet, most people are so ignorant of God’s law that they do not allow it to influence them in making even the most important decisions and choices in life. Of course, this results in making poor decisions and choices which are detrimental to ones eternal soul. It is still true— *“My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge....”* (Hosea 4:6a). If you love God’s Law you will make every effort to study and learn it.

No one can truthfully claim to love God’s Law

while standing in disobedience to it. Jesus said, *“If you love me, keep my commandments”* (John 14:15). One cannot love Jesus without obeying what Jesus has commanded for that is the way our love for Him is expressed. The Bible reads, *“For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments. And His commandments are not burdensome”* (1 John 5:3). One who knows God’s law but chooses to violate it anyway engages in willful sin of which the Word of God declares, *“For if we sin willfully after we have received the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins, but a certain fearful expectation of judgment, and fiery indignation which will devour the adversaries”* (Hebrews 10:26-27).

It is our hope that each of us will see the need of knowing, obeying and loving God’s Law. The Psalmist expresses the tremendous result of *loving God’s law in the words of Psalms 119:165, “Great peace have those who love Your law, And nothing causes them to stumble.”* Rather than viewing God’s Law as restrictive and burdensome, as so many seem to do, we need to see it for what it does for us. God’s law brings us peace with Him in this life and in eternity. Can you honestly say, **“Oh how I love Your law?”**

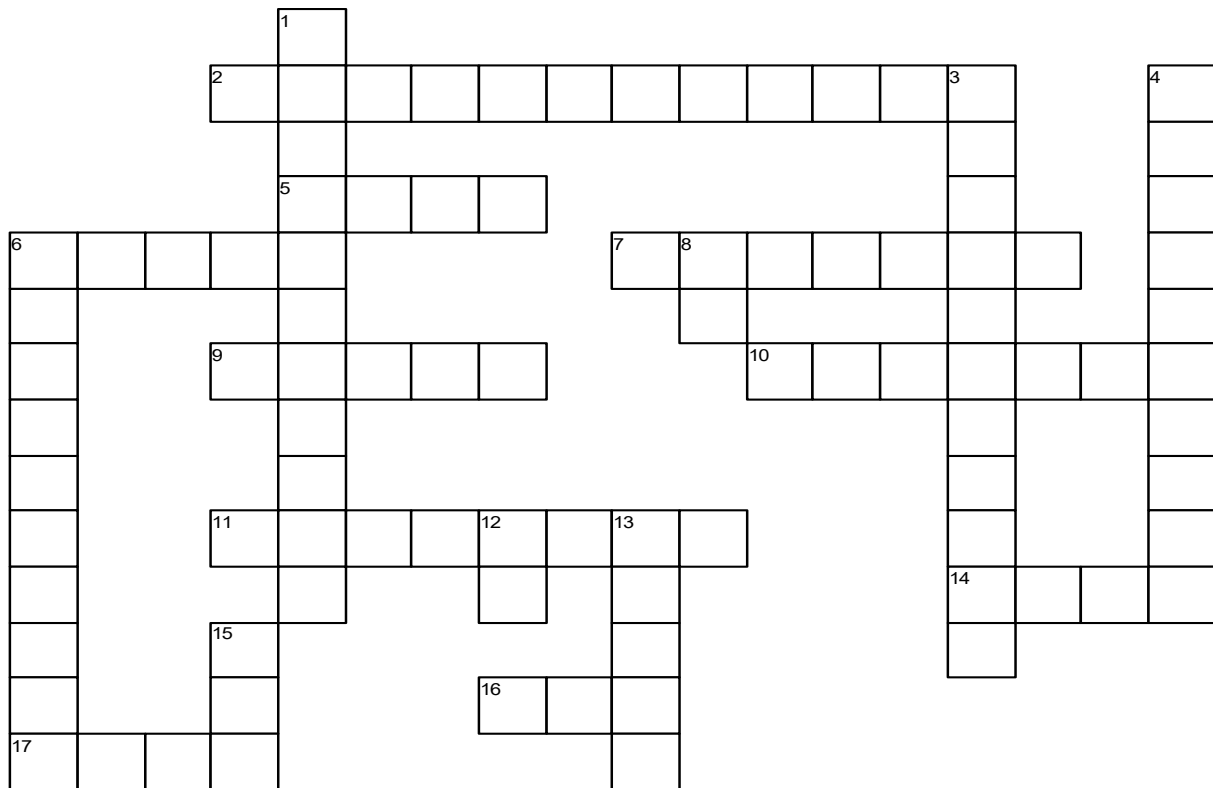

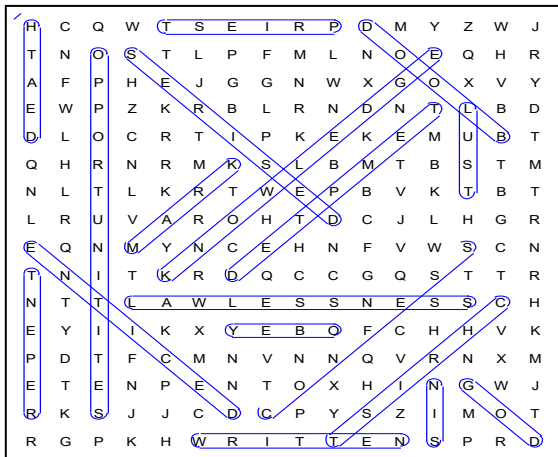
