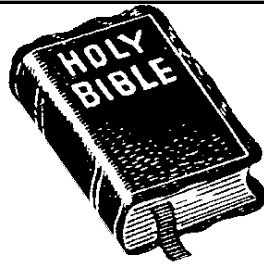

THANKSGIVING

*“Offer to God **thanksgiving**, And pay your vows to the Most High” (Psalm 50:14).*

This past week our nation celebrated the Thanksgiving holiday. Thanksgiving Day became an official federal holiday in 1863 during the civil war. However, its background goes all the way back to the time of the Pilgrims after their first harvest in the “New World” in 1621 in which they shared their bounty with 90 native Americans in a three day feast. This was a time of thanking to God for His blessings.

Those who are Christians have much for which to be thankful—the love and grace of God, the sacrifice of Jesus Christ for our sins, the church of Christ, the spiritual blessings which are available in Christ, the fellowship of brethren, the hope of heaven, and our families, just to name a few. In addition, the expression of our thanksgiving to God is not limited to one day a year. Our thanksgiving may be expressed in our daily prayers—*“Continue earnestly in prayer, being vigilant in it with **thanksgiving**” (Colossians 4:2). “Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with **thanksgiving**, let your requests be made known to God” (Philippians 4:6). “Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of our lips, **giving thanks** to His name” (Hebrews 13:15). With so much for which to be thankful to God one day a year is not enough to express it. Every day is “thanksgiving day” for the saved! “**But thanks be to God**, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ” (1 Corinthians 15:57).*

The lack of appreciation and the failure to express thanksgiving to God for what He has done for us is sinful. One of the reasons given for the rejection of God by idolatrous Gentiles in Romans chapter one is that *“...although they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God, **nor were thankful**, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened” (Rom. 1:21). Those who reject the existence of God will certainly fall into the category of the “unthankful.” Though God is good to the “unthankful and evil” (Luke 6:35), the unthankful and evil do not give thanks for the goodness of God nor take advantage of the opportunities God’s goodness grants. We are now living in the “perilous times” of the “last days” which are characterized by those who are “unthankful” - among other things (2 Timothy 3:1ff). In a society where so many people view government handouts as being owed to them, where is the attitude of thanks-giving? In a country where material wealth abounds, where is the attitude of thanksgiving? Instead of thanksgiving our society is polluted with greed, avarice and ungratefulness even though God has blessed us abundantly in this nation with many material blessings (Matthew 5:45).*

Let us not be guilty of possessing an attitude of un-thankfulness. Rather, let us have the attitude expressed by inspiration: *“Now **thanks be to God** who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and through us diffuses the fragrance of His knowledge in every place” (2 Corinthians 2:14). We have so much for which to be thankful but especially the salvation provided for us through Jesus Christ. Let us never take it for granted. God gives to us the hope of everlasting life in heaven with Him. A greater blessing one cannot even begin to imagine. Let us say with the inspired Paul, “**Thanks be to God for His indescribable gift!**” (2 Corinthians 9:15).*

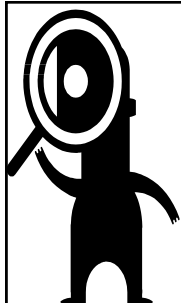
